REGULATIONS APPLICABLE FOR THE

"CIPRIAN PORUMBESCU" INTERNATIONAL CHAMBER MUSIC COMPETITION

Suceava, June 18 - 20, 2025

1. ORGANIZERS

"Ciprian Porumbescu" International Festival is a cultural initiative of the Suceava County Council, which is also the main sponsor of the event. The organizer of the festival is the "Bucovina" Cultural Center.

2. PRIZES

- 2.1. The International Chamber Music Competition "Ciprian Porumbescu" will offer the following prizes:
 - a) Festival Trophy: 3.000 euros;
 - b)1st Prize: 2.000 euros:
 - c)2nd Prize: 1.500 euros:
 - 3rd Prize: 1.000 euros.
- 2.2. The prizes will be awarded in the national currency, based on the official National Bank of Romania exchange rate, and will be subject to taxation according to the law.
- 2.3. The winning chamber music ensemble of the "Ciprian Porumbescu" International Chamber Music Festival Trophy will be invited to perform a recital at the next edition of the festival.

3. THE JURY

- 3.1. The jury will establish, during a technical meeting prior to the festival, the methods and criteria for evaluating the participants.
- 3.2. The jury will determine the ranking and prizes to be awarded in the competition.
- 3.3. The jury's decisions are final; no appeals will be accepted.
- 3.4. The competition jury will be composed of musicians recognized both nationally and internationally, as follows:

4. COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- **4.1.** The competition is open to all chamber ensembles: trios, quartets, quintets, sextets.
- 4.2. Participants will present 2 or 3 works in the competition, contrasting in character and style, with a total duration of 20-30 minutes. Participants must submit the sheet music of the works they will perform electronically. 4.3. The age of participants must be between 18 and 35 years/member.
- 4.4. The final deadline for registration is June 10, 2025. Registration will be done by accessing the link https://festivalulciprianporumbescu.com/inscriere-muzica-de-camera/, and registration forms must be accompanied by a copy of an identity document to verify the maximum permitted age.
- 4.5. Participants will consent to the processing of their personal data by completing the registration form.
- 4.6. By registering for the competition, participants agree to the potential publication of photographic, audio, and videographic materials by the festival organizers, both online and in the media. These materials may be used for advertising purposes, to present and highlight the importance of the festival.
- 4.7. By completing and submitting the registration form, each candidate agrees to the terms and conditions of the competition's regulations. The original version of the regulations in Romanian governs in the case of any interpretation issues.
- 4.8. No registration fees will be charged for the competition.
- 4.9. Accommodation and meal expenses will be covered by the participants, while travel expenses will be covered by the organizers.
- 4.10. The "Ciprian Porumbescu" International Festival is not responsible for any costs related to illness and/or accidents of the candidates during their stay in Suceava.
- 4.11. The "Ciprian Porumbescu" International Festival is not responsible for the loss/theft of personal belongings/musical instruments within the competition area.
- 4.12. By registering for the competition, participants agree to the storage and use of their personal data by the "Ciprian Porumbescu" International Festival for the purpose of organizing the competition.
